

MINUTES OF THE MONTHLY/REVIEW MEETING IN CONNECTION WITH COMPUTERIZATION OF SUPPLY CHAIN IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE ORDER OF THE HON'BLE SUPREME COURT OF INDIA IN W.P(C) NO.196/2001 AS WELL AS GOVT. The meeting was presided over by Sri. B.C.Bora, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Hailakandi.

At the outset, the Deputy Commissioner, Hailakandi welcomed the member present in the meeting and review the progress of the minutes of the meeting held on 05.12.2011.

In the 1st step, the Deputy Commissioner, Hailakandi review the progress of the computerization of beneficiaries data in GPSS wise.

Secondly, review the submission of weekly distribution report of S.K.Oil depot and beneficiaries data of urban F.P.Shops.

The Secretary M/s. Mohanpur GPSS Ltd opined that almost all the GPSS Ltd are facing problems of bifurcated family living in a same holding.

Discussion was held about the performance of Aamar Dokhan and procurement of Paddy.

After threadbare discussion, the following resolutions were adopted in the meeting.

1. All the GPSS Ltd will submit all categories of beneficiaries data with C.D within 20.12.2011 and concerned Area Officer will take liason with the GPSS Ltd for completion of the process within the fixed date. If any GPSS Ltd failed to complete the work within the fixed date, the matter will be brought to the notice of Govt. for taking necessary step against the GPSS and concern Area Officer, F, CS & CA will be held responsible and mark in their A.C.R.
2. The next review meeting will be held on 22.12.2011 at 11.30 A.M in the conference hall of Deputy Commissioner's office. All Area Officer, F, CS & CA will inform their respective GPSS/PDS nominees and F.P.Shop to attend in the meeting.
3. The GPSS Ltd tagged with PDS nominees will lift & distribute their allotted quantities of PDS/TPDS items within the month subject to availability of stock and submit monthly report/Utilization Certificate of every items within 1st day of the month.
4. All Area Officer, F, CS & CA will submit daily lifting & distribution report of the GPSS/PDS nominees to the Deputy Commissioner, Hailakandi.
5. The S.K.Oil depots will submit weekly lifting and distribution report in computer sheet with breakup (GPSS Ltd/S.K.Oil Hawker/ Urban F.P.Shops) to their concerned Area Officer, F, CS & CA & Area Officer will take to steps to upload the same in the website.
6. The training will be organized in 3(three) phases : - (a) Office level, (b) GPSS/Nominees/S.K.Oil depot level, (c) F.P.Shop level through Amtron.
7. Daily progress report for computerization of beneficiaries data to be submitted by the Area Officers, F, CS & CA, Hailakandi to Deputy Commissioner, Hailakandi in GPSS level/Urban F.P.Shop level.
8. All Area Officers, F, CS & CA, Hailakandi will submit weekly report in every Saturday and if Saturday is the holiday, the same will submit on Friday for submission of weekly report to Govt. on every Monday.

9. GPSS will submit the list of bogus/ghost F.I.Card at the time of submission of C.D, if detected.
10. It was decided in the meeting that if separate holding of E/Roll for bifurcated family not available, the GPSS Ltd as well as urban F.P.Shops will follow the holding of census, 2011.
11. The urban F.P.Shops also submit their beneficiaries data to the concerned Area Officer, F, CS & CA within 20.12.2011 and Area Officer, F, CS & CA will take step to upload the data in the website before the next review meeting.
12. The owner of the Aamar Dokhan informed the house that prices of onion, Potato & Engine Oil in Hailakandi market within the limit of consumers. It was decided that if Aamar Dokhan is willing to financial assistance then Deputy Commissioner, Hailakandi will take up the matter with the Lead District Manager, UBI, Hailakandi for sanctioning the loan to Aamar Dokhan with interest subsidy and also decided in the meeting that the F, CS & CA Department, Hailakandi will contact with Agriculture Department, Hailakandi for procurement of paddy.
13. It was decided in the meeting that all GPSS Ltd will submit transportation bill of AAY rice within 20.12.2011 to the Asstt. Director, F, CS & CA, Hailakandi positively.

Before conclusion of the meeting, the Deputy Commissioner, Hailakandi advised all the member presents in the meeting that they will co-operate with District Administration for successful implementation of the Govt. scheme as per direction. Also requested all the member present to distribute the PDS/TPDS goods to the consumers as per scale and Govt. fixed rate within the period.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks from the chair.


